To achieve this, we continuously optimise our processes, promote the use of energy-efficient technologies, and rely on environmentally responsible supply chains. Our objective is to minimise our environmental footprint and contribute to global climate protection. Our guidelines ensure that the procurement of our raw materials is carried out responsibly and in an environmentally friendly manner. Should exceptions be required for technical reasons that do not comply with our basic principles, we proactively and transparently inform our customers.

Our production standards are aligned with the following regulations and directives:

- **EU REACH Regulation (EC No. 1907/2006):** This includes substances of very high concern (SVHCs) that are subject to mandatory reporting.
- **RoHS Directive (2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU):** This aims to reduce the use of lead, mercury, and cadmium.
- **PFAS monitoring:** We monitor the PFAS content of all raw materials processed in our production. The limit value defined by us is a maximum of 0.1%.
